Tech Tips

I have had people ask in the past what should an engine read out as far as compression is concerned. Reading *A Antics* a while back, I was looking for an idea for testing the engine compression. I found this scale which should give a ballpark idea due to the quality of the gage and how many times the head has been trued up and design differences. Take this as a baseline and factor in the other possibilities that affect compression.

<u>Compression ratio</u>	<u>Pressure reading</u>
5.0	80
5.5	90
6.0	100
6.5	110
7.0	120
7.5	130
8.0	140
8.5	150

To do a compression check, remove the spark plugs and disconnect the coil wire. Insert the compression tester in the plughole, have someone engage the starter; if you have a push button starter solenoid as in some of the earlier cars, you do not need assistance. Spin the engine over at least five compression strokes.

An interesting way to check for compression loss is to remove the porcelain from an old spark plug and braze in a tire valve, so you can apply air pressure to each cylinder. Bring each cylinder to top dead center on the compression stroke then apply air pressure. The piston should not move, if it is close to TDC it won't. With the air applied listen for air leaks at the following sources;

1. Exhaust pipe – leaking exhaust valves
2. Air cleaner – leaking intake valves
3. Oil filler cap – piston rings
4. Radiator cap (look for bubbles) – leaking head gasket or cracked cylinder head
