### Pumpkin Apple Muffins

- |                                   |                        |
|-----------------------------------|------------------------|
| 1 ½ c. whole wheat flour          | 1 c. all purpose flour |
| 1 c. chopped, peeled, cored apple | 1 c. raisins           |
| 1 T. pumpkin pie spice            | ½ c. chopped walnuts   |
| 1 ¼ tsp baking powder             | 2 cups sugar           |
| 1 c. canned solid pack pumpkin    | 2 eggs                 |
| ½ c. packed brown sugar           | 2 T. flour             |
| ½ tsp. grnd cinnamon              | ½ c. vegetable oil     |
| ¼ c. butter, chilled              |                        |

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease eighteen ½ cup muffin cups, or line with muffin papers. Sift whole-wheat flour, 1 cup flour, pumpkin pie spice and baking powder into medium bowl. Stir sugar, pumpkin, oil and eggs in a large bowl until well mixed. Mix in apples, raisins, walnuts and whole-wheat + flour mixture. Place equal amounts of batter into prepared muffin cups. **Topping:**Combine brown sugar, 2 Tbls.

flour and cinnamon in a small bowl. Cut in chilled butter until mixture is crumbly. Sprinkle topping over muffin batter. Bake 30 minutes or until muffins test done with cake tester. Remove to rack to cool. Makes 18 muffins.

We enjoyed these at the Christmas party and Lois Wright was kind enough to share this delicious recipe with us. Thank you Lois.

### **Tight Fight for the Finish at the Classic Motorsports Small Bore Series**

Holly Hill, Fla.—The Classic Motorsports Small Bore Cup series is a snapshot of the glory days of American sports car racing in the 1950s and '60s. Each endurance race takes fans and drivers on a trip into the history of speed thanks to sports cars from iconic makes like Triumph, MG, Lotus, Porsche, Alfa and Elva.

Historic Sportscar Racing sanctioned the season finale at Georgia's Savannah Harbor Race Course on October 28-30. Rob Parker took first place in his BMW 2002tii, followed by Charles Kates, Jr. in a Lotus 7 and Dennis Gonzales in an Austin-Healey Sprite.

Things were different in the series points championship though: Kates came in first, Gonzales second, and William Power pulled in third place with his Datsun 2000 Roadster. These wins were well earned, following a strong season of events on both the East and West coasts.

If you feel like you missed out on all the fun, the Small Bore Enduro series will be back in 2012. The dates for the 2012 events are:
